

Reading a Webpage

Read left to right - top to bottom right

Press Command+ F or Ctrl+F and use a one keyword to search a long page.

Use Headings

Look for navigation bars or buttons.

Use links to explore and learn more.

Use a search that only looks on this site.

Look for illustrations and simple summaries to help you understand.

Look for buttons to contents. Use these to understand what is covered.

Get websites with simpler reading levels if needed.

Other Tips:

Command+Click (Ctrl+Click) on search results to open web pages in a new tab.

Use Reading levels for web searches in Google (see pic to right)

Get the computer to read the text to you. (Text to speech quick key as set on your computer)

Use keywords like "kids" or "introduction" to get simpler reading levels.
