

Behavior: This is how we respond to others, the roles we take up, the language(s) we speak, and our type of nonverbal communication. It reflects values. Aspects to be listed in this category include language, gender roles, family structure, political affiliation, how we organise ourselves

Concrete items: clothes, music, food, games, etc. These aspects of culture are often those that provide the focus for multicultural "festivals" or "celebrations."

Systems: This includes value systems, customs, spirituality, religion, worldview, beliefs etc.
